Religion

During our religion time, we have been learning about the Israelites, Joshua, and Gideon.

Here is some background information which I shared with the students to get them thinking about our Bible stories for this week.

In our stories of Joshua and Gideon this week we learned that one thing is clear: that God's people overcomes "Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit, says the Lord of hosts" (Zechariah 4:6). This saying is definitely true when it comes to the Battle of Jericho. What commander tires out his troops before battle? Only one who knows that "it is the Lord your God who fights for you, just as He promised you" (Joshua 23:10).

Next, we learn about Gideon and we enter the part of the Bible which revolved around the Judges for about 300 years. Chaos ensued and the people (not God) decided what was right and what was wrong. Gideon was an ordinary person whom God chose to accomplish great things in His time. This example makes sense when we read the story of Gideon leading the people. Gideon with the help of God defeats the Midianites and accomplishes that with only 300 soldiers.
